ASYMPTOMATIC CONTACT OF A POSITIVE CASE	<ul> <li>Self-monitor for symptoms</li> <li>Avoid contact with vulnerable people</li> <li>Wear a mask during all social interactions</li> <li>Practice physical distancing of 2 meters where possible</li> <li>If symptoms develop see section 2</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>5-day isolation from same date as the case</li> <li>Self-monitor for symptoms</li> <li>Days 6-10 continue to monitor for symptoms, avoid contact with vulnerable people, wear a mask during all social interactions, practice physical distancing of 2 meters where possible</li> <li>*it is not necessary to prolong isolation for each new positive case in the same family</li> </ul>
