

#### **RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:**

- 2 Negative rapid tests administered 24-36 hours apart
- No fever, vomiting or gastrointestinal symptoms

#### **RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:**

- 2 Negative rapid tests administered 24-36 hours apart
- No fever, vomiting or gastrointestinal symptoms



#### WHEN YOU RETURN:

- Masking during social interaction while symptomatic
- Self monitor for symptoms
- Physical distancing
- Avoid vulnerable people

#### WHEN YOU RETURN:

- Up to and including the full 10day period from the onset of symptoms:
  - Continue masking
  - Physical distancing
  - Avoid vulnerable people



- For 10 days from contact with positive case:
  - Self-monitor for symptoms
  - Physical distancing
  - Avoid vulnerable people
- Follow column 1 if symptoms develop

- School remains open
- Affected classroom=masked for 5 days as of date of reported positive case, when moving. Alone at desk can be unmasked
- Not necessary to prolong isolation for each new positive case in the same family
- Measures for vaccinated and unvaccinated students are the same
- \*Close contact means: proximity, duration in close contact, household members, sexual partners
- Symptoms 1 sym: fever, loss taste or smell, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, sore throat
  2 sym: runny nose/congest., headache, fatigue, muscle aches, loss appetite, nausea/vomiting, stomach ache or
  diarrhea
