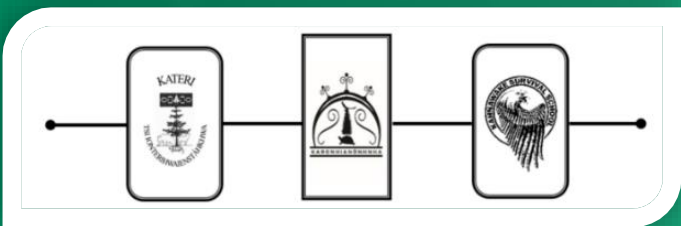

<p><u>COME TO SCHOOL?</u></p> <p>No</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>ISOLATION PERIOD</u></p> <p>24-36 hours (IF POSITIVE, REFER TO COLUMN 2)</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 Negative rapid tests administered 24-36 hours apart</li><li>• No fever, vomiting or gastrointestinal symptoms</li></ul> <p><u>WHEN YOU RETURN:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Masking during social interaction while symptomatic</li><li>• Self monitor for symptoms</li><li>• Physical distancing</li><li>• Avoid vulnerable people</li></ul>	<p><u>COME TO SCHOOL?</u></p> <p>No</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>ISOLATION PERIOD</u></p> <p>5 Days (FROM START OF SYMPTOMS) (Up to 10 days if continue to test positive)</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 2 Negative rapid tests administered 24-36 hours apart</li><li>• No fever, vomiting or gastrointestinal symptoms</li></ul> <p><u>WHEN YOU RETURN:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Up to and including the full 10-day period from the onset of symptoms:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Continue masking</li><li>○ Physical distancing</li><li>○ Avoid vulnerable people</li></ul></li></ul>	<p><u>COME TO SCHOOL?</u></p> <p>Yes</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>ISOLATION PERIOD</u></p> <p>None</p> <p>↓</p> <p><u>WHAT NEXT:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For 10 days from contact with positive case:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Self-monitor for symptoms</li><li>○ Physical distancing</li><li>○ Avoid vulnerable people</li></ul></li><li>• Follow column 1 if symptoms develop</li></ul>

- School remains open
- Affected classroom=masked for 5 days as of date of reported positive case, when moving. Alone at desk can be unmasked
- Not necessary to prolong isolation for each new positive case in the same family
- Measures for vaccinated and unvaccinated students are the same
- \*Close contact means: proximity, duration in close contact, household members, sexual partners
- Symptoms – 1 sym: fever, loss taste or smell, new or worsening cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, sore throat  
2 sym: runny nose/congest., headache, fatigue, muscle aches, loss appetite, nausea/vomiting, stomach ache or diarrhea
