School Re-entry Requirements after Travel for KEC Staff and Students

Those who have traveled must monitor for COVID-19 related symptoms, complete the mandatory online daily health check form and follow local public health guidelines. Students and staff may return to school immediately following March break should they not exhibit any COVID-19 related symptoms.

Masking Measures for the KEC

As we have stated throughout the pandemic, the safety of our students and staff is our top priority. The KEC is aware of the recent developments highlighting the provincial wide removal of masks. However, our approach remains a cautious one; masks for our KEC schools and administrative offices shall remain in place, with regular monitoring over the next few weeks to assess whether easing those measures is appropriate for our students and staff.
